Zero Tolerance BAC .00%

1<sup>st</sup> Offense: 1 year revocation

2<sup>nd</sup> Offense: 2 year revocation

Zero Tolerance BAC .01%

1 year license suspension

Zero Tolerance BAC .02% - .05%

1<sup>st</sup> Offense – 3 month revocation

2<sup>nd</sup> Offense – 6 month revocation

3<sup>rd</sup> Offense – 1 year revocation

## Idaho:

Zero tolerance BAC .02%

1<sup>st</sup> Offense: 90 day mandatory suspension after which a driver may request restricted driving

privileges; possibility a 1 year suspension

2<sup>nd</sup> Offense: 1 year mandatory suspension

Possibility a 2 year suspension

Zero Tolerance BAC .02%

1<sup>st</sup> Offense: 90 days suspension

2<sup>nd</sup> Offense: 6 month suspension

3<sup>rd</sup> Offense: 1 year suspension

Zero tolerance BAC .02%

1<sup>st</sup> and Subsequent Offenses: 1 year revocation

Zero Tolerance BAC .00%

1<sup>st</sup> Offense Implied Consent Law: 90 day suspension

1<sup>st</sup> Conviction (Additional Sentence): 1 year revocation

2<sup>nd</sup> Offense Implied Consent Law: 1 year suspension

2<sup>nd</sup> Conviction (Additional Sentence): 3 year revocation

\*\*People less than 18 years of age convicted of a DUI will have their driving privileges suspended until they are 18 years old or are eligible for reinstatement, whichever comes later.

Zero Tolerance BAC .02%

1<sup>st</sup> Offense: 90 day suspension

Subsequent Offense: 1 year revocation or until age 21, whichever is longer
