Probable Cause Statement
Roy Case # 2012-1931

On January 25th 2012 at about 1130 hours [REDACTED] met with me at Roy High School. [REDACTED] brought forth information about a student who had a plan to hurt other students at Roy High School.

[REDACTED] had exchanged text messages [REDACTED] with Joshua Hoggan. Joshua is a student at Roy High School. Joshua began telling the student about his emotional feelings. Joshua sent the following texts:

"If I tell you one day not to go to school, make damn sure you and [REDACTED] are not there."

"I get the feeling you know what I'm planning."

"It's not all me either"

"Dallin is in on it" "He wants revenge on the world too."

"We both want to, and we have a plan to get away with it too."

"Explosives, airport, airplane"

"We ain't gonna crash it, we're just gonna kill and fly our way to a country that won't send us back to the US."

"Life....plus a huge ass backstory that makes me hate people."

"Another reason is that I just don't care. I'm pretty much a lying cheating, manipulator with everyone except seven people. Everyone else is just a piece."

[REDACTED] came forward and showed a text from Joshua stating:

"I've just been kinda planning my get back at the world thing and I figured if you had anyone you wanted revenge on, I could see if I have anything planned."

The Roy High School administration pulled Dallin Morgan from class and interviewed him about the plan to kill people at the school. Dallin admitted to being part of the plan. The administrators found a map of Roy High with pen ink marking where the cameras were and the blind spots of the cameras. Dallin confirmed to me that it was a recon of the cameras and where to hide in the blind spots.

I interviewed Joshua Hoggan. Joshua admitted to tossing the idea of a plan to use a bomb at Roy High School. During the interview, Joshua revealed that he was fascinated about the Columbine High School Shooting. Joshua advised that he flew to Denver Colorado where he went to Columbine High School and interviewed the Principal. It was confirmed by Columbine Principal Frank DeAngelis that Joshua arrived on 12/12/2011 at 11 am to interview him about Columbine's mass killing. Joshua told me that he was offended that he was compared to the Columbine killers. Joshua was offended by the fact that those killers only completed one percent of their plan and he was much more intelligent than that. Joshua explained to me that he could complete his plan due to how intelligent he is. Joshua explained that he has made a pipe bomb before. Dallin said Joshua had made the pipe bomb using "gun power and rocket fuel." Dallin told me that Joshua bragged about using a bomb to blow up a mail box and having three hand guns in his house. Joshua claimed that he did not have the guns but Dallin was the source of the guns because he is eighteen and can purchase a gun.

Joshua's plan was to steal a plane from Ogden Airport and make their escape after setting off a bomb off during an assembly. Joshua said he practiced on a computer flight simulator on a computer in his home.

Dear Royal Parents,

On January 25th, contact was made with the Roy High Administration that led to concerns that two students from Roy High were involved in making plans and taking steps to harm students and faculty at Roy High.

The information was provided to law enforcement for evaluation and an investigation was initiated. Two individuals were detained and arrested based on the information received and additional information discovered in the preliminary phase of the investigation.

Immediate action was taken to secure Roy High School and clear it of any potential threats. With assistance from the Weber County Bomb Disposal Unit, Alcohol Tobacco and Firearms (ATF) and K-9 Units from around Northern Utah with certification in the identification of bombs and explosives. No items were discovered and Roy High is in session as normal.

If your student has any information that you feel would be relevant to the situation please contact Roy High School Administration. We appreciate your support in regards to this unfortunate incident. We are confident that Roy High School is a safe, great school.
