

**List of what to purchase:**

**(Divide items between siblings. Have them bring multiples of their items for the number of families participating).**

1. Box of hot cocoa
2. Dish towels
3. Popcorn
4. Gift wrap
5. Soup mix (such as [Bear Creek](#))
6. Paper plates & utensils
7. Oranges
8. Rolls ([Rhodes](#) or pre-baked)
9. Holiday cookie rolls ([Pillsbury](#))
10. Drinking cups
11. Frozen lasagna
12. A CD full of holiday music

## Supplies for tags:

3 pieces of white cardstock

1 ½” circle punch

2” scallop circle

Corner rounder (1/4” inch)

12 – 3” pieces of holiday ribbon

7 holiday sacks (I got mine at [Target](#) for \$0.50 each!)

Stapler

Scrapbook adhesive

## Instructions

1. Print out tags on white cardstock
2. Cut the circle tags with a 1 ½” circle punch.
3. Cut rectangular tags 3 ½” x 2”. Round edges on right side of tag.
4. Use a 2” scallop circle punch and punch 12 circles out of dark green or pattern paper.
5. Attach printed circle inside of green scallop circle.
6. Attach circle to rectangle, with ½ of the circle hanging over the edge.
7. Place a strip of ribbon vertically over tag. Lay over the folded over bag and staple to bottom portion of green scallop circle.
8. Tie a knot with ribbon.
