I state that I am the Assistant Chief for the West Valley City Police Department, of West Valley City, a municipal corporation in the State of Utah.

This is a law enforcement Social Security Administration request under GN 03312.040 - Valid Law Enforcement Requests, and GN 03312.005 - Disclosure for Criminal Law Enforcement Purposes Involving Violent Crimes.

The West Valley City Police Department is currently investigating the probable violent homicide and kidnapping of the indicated person, Susan Marie Powell. The case is being investigated under case number 09-213 assigned by the Third Judicial District Court, State of Utah, and this investigation is currently sealed by secrecy order from the same court.

What records are requested - The records requested in regards to this matter should indicate any and all activity related to the usage of Social Security Administration number [REDACTED] assigned to Susan Marie Powell, also having used the maiden name of Cox.

Why the records are necessary - The records are necessary to initiate a successful criminal prosecution for the probable crimes of homicide and kidnapping.
