She said yes, either one. If the something was an accident look at Josh, but if it was a Lori Hacking type thing, it would be Josh. I might have asked her why she thought something might happen to her (or she just expanded on her reason for telling me to look at Josh), but it wasn't a direct threat that had her worried. It was that Josh always talked about how he thought he could get away with murder. It appeared to make her nervous that he talked about it so much, and that when he spoke about it he didn't do it in a joking manner. She felt he was seriously thinking about doing something because he seemed to think he was smart enough to get away with it.
