On 12-07-09 Susan Powell was reported missing by her mother-in-law when she failed to show up at her work. Mrs. Powell's residence was checked and she was not located there. Mrs. Powell's husband Joshua was interviewed and made statements that were suspicious. Mrs. Powell was last seen on 12-06-09 and as of today's date is still missing. Evidence and information have been located to suggest that Mr. Powell may have injured or killed Mrs. Powell at which time he drove her out to the West Desert near Dugway Proving Grounds to dispose of her body in one of the many mine shafts located in that area.

INSTRUCTIONS

NARRATIVE:

The objective of this operation is to visually inspect mineshafts with a borehole camera in the West Desert near Dugway Proving Grounds for victim Susan Powell's body. The operation will start on January 04, 2010 and will go for two weeks until January 14, 2010. Individuals assigned to this operation will be staying in barracks at the Dugway Proving Grounds Military Base. Prior to each days searches, a map will be emailed to Sgt. Bobrowski with the location of the mines that will be searched that day. Everyday at 1200 hrs and 1700 hrs Sgt. Bobrowski will be contacted by phone with an update/status report.

While inspecting the mineshafts with the borehole camera, personnel will wear a body safety harness that will be tied off to a secure structure or vehicle away from the mineshaft opening. Training on this safety equipment will be conducted by the members of the Department of Natural Resources prior to the operation starting.

As many mineshafts as possible will be checked during the two week period. At the end of the two week period this operation will be re-evaluated by WVPD administration who will decide if the operation will continue further.

EVIDENCE RECOVERY PLAN

During this operation the general concept will be to operate as "low key" as possible to avoid alerting Josh Powell, media or others not involved in the operation or case. In the event Susan Powell is located the following will occur:

- 1. Site detectives and DNR personnel will immediately video record the area/scene and will not enter the scene.
- 2. Notification will be made to Sgt. Bobrowski via satellite phone by Detective Greco.
- 3. One site detective will depart the scene with DVD video and deliver the DVD directly to Sgt. Bobrowski.
- 4. Remaining site personnel will remain at the scene until relieved by scene security provided by WVCPD.
- 5. After review and confirmation:
 - a. Detectives Maxwell and Cook will immediately travel to Puyallup, Wa. to coordinate with Pierce COSO in anticipation of arrest warrant, subsequent search warrants and notification to Cox family.
 - b. Detectives Marx and Dain will contact Deputy D.A.
 Sandra Johnson and begin screening process and obtain information/arrest warrant.
 - c. Detectives Davis, Waelty and Peterson will return to scene with site detective and begin a scene security schedule (minimum two detectives).
 - d. Sgt. Bobrowski will make in person contact with OME with video of site.
- 6. Sgt. Bobrowski will notify mine rescue personnel through DNR command.

- 7. Mine rescue team will conduct recovery of evidence if within mine shaft if evidence is above ground and not within an immediate area of mine WVCPD/OME will recover evidence.
- 8. OME personnel will assume custody of human remains.
