14 WHERE WAS SHE AT IN THE HOUSE?
15 JP: HUH! UM..SHE WAS WEARING....AH.....SHE WAS JUST WEARING
16 SOMETHING COMFORTABLE.
17 EM: WHAT IS SOMETHING COMFORTABLE?
18 JP: JUST A CRAPPY OLD SHIRT I, I MEAN I DON'T KNOW SPECIFICALLY
19 BUT YOU KNOW WHEN WE'RE AT HOME WE TEND TO WEAR JUST
20 SHIRTS THAT WE DON'T MIND DOING WORK IN.
21 EM: OKAY, SO AN OLD SHIRT WHAT COLOR?
22 JP: AH...I DON'T KNOW.
23 EM: WHAT ELSE WAS SHE WEARING?
24 JP: I CAN'T REMEMBER.
25 EM: YOU SAID JUST AN OLD SHIRT?

26 JP: UM WELL AH SHE WAS WEARING SOCKS AND AH SEEMS LIKE SOME
27 KIND OF SWEAT PANTS.
28 EM: WHAT COLOR WERE THE SWEAT PANTS?
29 JP: AH...I DON'T KNOW, I.....
30 EM: OKAY, WHERE WAS SHE AT IN THE HOUSE?
31 JP: SHE WAS IN THE LIVING ROOM.....WE WERE FINISHING UP A MOVIE.
32 EM: WHAT MOVIE DID YOU GUYS WATCH?
33 JP: UM SANTA CLAUS 3.
34 BOY: MOM WANTS MORE.
35 JP: HERE YA GO BUDDY. HOLD ON COME HERE, I, I POURED SOME IN
36 FOR YA.
37 BOY: NO I
38 JP: OH 2-YEAR-OLDS RIGHT. UM CAN I GO GET HIM SOME WATER?
39 EM: YEAH ABSOLUTELY GO AHEAD.....
40 JP: OKAY.....COME ON LET'S GO, YOU GUYS BOTH HAVE TO STAY IN
41 HERE OKAY BRAYDON.....
42 BOY: OKAY.
43 JP: ALRIGHT.....
44 EM: OKAY, LET'S TALK ABOUT UM.....WHERE WOULD SHE BE AT, I MEAN
45 SHE'S YOUR WIFE? AND OBVIOUSLY EVERYBODY'S CONCERNED.
46 JP: I CAN'T.
47 EM: EVERYBODY'S WORRIED EVERYBODY'S WORRIED ABOUT ALL FOUR
48 OF YOU. I MEAN WE START
49 JP: YEAH AND I CALLED BACK
50 EM: GETTING PHONE CALLS AT 10:00 O'CLOCK THIS MORNING AND
51 JP: I DIDN'T EVEN KNOW THAT WAS HAPPENING I APOLOGIZE FOR
52 THAT. LIKE I SAY WE GOT SNOWED IN AND THERE'S JUST NO CELL
53 SERVICE SO IT KILLED MY PHONE YOU KNOW?
54 EM: UM HUH.
55 JP: IT JUST TRIES HARDER AND DIES YOU KNOW?
56 EM: UM HUH.

57 JP: UM....IN FACT I ACTUALLY TURNED IT OFF SO TO TRY AND SAVE
58 THE BATTERY. UM....YOU KNOW ON SUNDAYS A LOT OF TIMES SHE
59 GOES TO A FRIENDS HOUSE, SOMETIMES SHE JUST GOES WITHOUT
60 SAYING ANYTHING. UM ONE OF THOSE PEOPLE IS [REDACTED],
61 AND [REDACTED], [REDACTED] AND [REDACTED].
62 EM: AND WHAT ABOUT THEM?
63 JP: UM I'VE FOUND HER OVER THERE A FEW TIMES.
64 EM: THEY LIVE IN THE NEIGHBORHOOD?
65 JP: YEAH.
66 EM: IS IT COMMON FOR HER TO BE THERE ALL DAY, NOT GO TO WORK?
67 JP: NO.
68 EM: OKAY CAUSE SHE WASN'T AT WORK.
69 JP: SHE, SHE NEVER MISSES, MISSES WORK WELL UNLESS SHE CALLS.
70 EM: RIGHT. SO WHERE, WHERE WOULD YOUR WIFE BE AT, WHERE DO
71 YOU THINK SHE WOULD BE AT?
72 JP: I DON'T KNOW I'M JUST THINKING ON HER WAY TO WORK BUT NOT
73 FOR THIS LONG.
74 EM: OKAY, WHO WOULD, HOW WOULD SHE GET TO WORK?
75 JP: WELL I DRIVE HER, WE DRIVE TOGETHER, WE, WE HAVE ONLY ONE
76 CAR SO, SO WE JUST MAKE IT WORK YOU KNOW
77 EM: OKAY
78 JP: BUT I MEAN SHE'S UM SHE ACTUALLY I, I DID THINK OF A FEW
79 OTHER PEOPLE WHO HAVE GIVEN HER RIDES BEFORE
80 EM: UM HUH.
81 JP: UM DEBBIE, HOLD ON I'VE GOT TO FIND MY BOY HE'S RUNNING....
82 [REDACTED] WHAT ARE YOU DOING?" "ARE YOU GOING POOP".
83 (INAUDIBLE TOO FAR AWAY)
84 RB: HEY ELLIS!
85 EM: YEAH.
86 RB: WOULD YOU LIKE AN ADVOCATE TO COME OUT AND HELP WITH
87 THE LITTLE ONES FOR A LITTLE BIT?

88 EM: YEAH IF THERE IS ONE THAT WOULD BE GREAT.

102 JP: [REDACTED] IS A DAY CARE PROVIDER.
103 EM: OH OKAY ALRIGHT I'VE SPOKE WITH HER.

105 EM: IS THERE ANYBODY ELSE THAT WOULD GIVE HER RIDES?

107 EM: I MEAN HOW OFTEN IS THAT SHE WOULD GET A RIDE FROM
108 SOMEBODY ELSE?
109 JP: UM [REDACTED], BUT I DON'T KNOW HER LAST NAME, SEEMS LIKE THERE
110 IS A LADY NAMED [REDACTED] AT HER WORK THAT SHE SOMETIMES
111 RIDES WITH.
112 EM: HOW OFTEN DOES SHE RIDE WITH SOMEBODY ELSE?
113 JP: UM
114 EM: I MEAN IS IT REALLY RARE?
115 JP: NO, NO SOME WHAT REGULAR. UM
116 EM: WHAT'S REGULAR ONCE A WEEK, ONCE A MONTH?

117 JP: NO PROBABLY....WELL IT DEPENDS I MEAN YOU KNOW IF I'M
118 TRYING TO GET HOME AND WORK ON STUFF AND SHE'S GONE AT
119 WORK AND I HAVE TO, WELL I GET OFF AT 4:00
120 EM: UM HUH.
121 JP: NORMALLY
122 EM: 4:00 P.M. OR 4:00 A.M.
123 JP: AND SHE GETS OFF AT 5:00 P.M. AND SHE GETS OFF AT 5:30
124 NORMALLY.
125 EM: UM HUH.
126 JP: AND SO SOMETIMES INSTEAD OF WAITING THE HOUR AND A HALF I
127 GO HOME AND JUST WORK, AND THEN SOMETIMES UM WHENEVER
128 POSSIBLE IF I'M ALREADY HOME WORKING UM THEN YOU KNOW
129 IT'S ALWAYS NICE WHEN SOMEONE ELSE CAN BRING HER HOME.

131 JP: AND I, I MEAN I IT SEEMS LIKE THERE'S MORE BUT I CAN'T THINK
132 OF IT.
133 EM: SO LET'S TALK ABOUT YESTERDAY I KNOW THAT UM YESTERDAY
134 JOVANNA CAME OVER ABOUT 3:00 O'CLOCK RIGHT?
135 JP: OKAY.
136 EM: UM...I GUESS HER SUSAN AND THE BOYS WENT TO CHURCH RIGHT?
137 JP: YEAH.
138 EM: LET'S TALK ABOUT YESTERDAY'S ACTIVITIES, WALK ME THROUGH
139 UM STEP BY STEP HOW YESTERDAY DEVELOPED, WHAT YOU GUYS
140 DID THROUGH OUT THE DAY INTO THE EVENING.
141 JP: UM...WELL...AH SUSAN WENT TO CHURCH
142 EM: UM HUH.
143 JP: IT WASN'T A REGULAR CHURCH IT WAS JUST
144 EM: YEAH CONFERENCE
145 JP: SOMETHING LIKE THAT YEAH IT WAS STATE, I THINK IT WAS STATE
146 CONFERENCE UM....AND WELL ANY WAY I STAYED HOME SO YOU

147 KNOW WHEN SHE GOT HOME WELL BEFORE SHE GOT HOME I
148 STARTED ON MY WAY TO THE STORE

158 EM: WHAT TIME WAS THAT AT?
159 JP: AH....I DON'T KNOW MAYBE 4:00 OR 4:30, WHAT DO YA NEED

161 BOY: I NEED A DRINK OF WATER
162 JP: OKAY GO AHEAD AND GET IT
163 EM: ANY, ANY REASON
164 JP: YOU KNOW HOW TO DO IT.
165 EM: SORRY, ANY REASON WHY SHE TOOK A NAP WAS ALL GOOD?
166 JP: WELL SHE SAID SHE WAS KIND OF TIRED.
167 EM: OKAY, WHAT WERE YOU GONNA SAY?
168 JP: I'VE GOT TO GO SEE WHAT MY SON IS
169 EM: OKAY
170 JP: I'LL, I'LL BE BACK.....
171 RB: [REDACTED] ON HER WAY FROM P.V.H.
172 EM: THANKS.....HUM...ALRIGHT SO SHE TOOK A NAP ABOUT 4:00, 4:30
173 THEN WHAT HAPPENED AFTER THAT?
174 JP: UM....WELL SEEMS LIKE SHE GOT UP.....I DON'T KNOW MAYBE 6:30

216 JP: JUST UM I THINK HE WAS SLEEPING IN HIS BED
217 EM: AND SUSAN WAS AWAKE?
218 JP: UM....HE CUDDLED WITH HER FOR A WHILE MAYBE I DON'T KNOW
219 ABOUT 20 MINUTES MAYBE I DON'T KNOW
220 EM: WELL WHERE WAS, WHERE WAS SUSAN AT WHEN YOU LEFT
221 BETWEEN 7:00 AND 8:00 O'CLOCK?
222 JP: WELL I, I DON'T KNOW I MEAN I, I'M JUST, I'M JUST TRYING TO PUT
223 IT TOGETHER YOU KNOW.
224 EM: BUT WAS SHE AWAKE
225 JP: I REMEMBER WHAT HAPPENED
226 EM: WAS SHE ASLEEP?
227 JP: BUT I DON'T REMEMBER EXACTLY WHAT
228 EM: WAS SHE AWAKE OR WAS SHE ASLEEP WHEN YOU LEFT?
229 JP: OH SHE WAS AWAKE

231 JP: I THINK [REDACTED] MIGHT HAVE BEEN IN BED BY THEN

258 JP: UM IT SEEMS LIKE THAT'S WHEN I READ HIM A STORY AND YOU
259 KNOW LIKE I SAY THE LITTLE ONE WAS ASLEEP AND THAT AND MY
260 OLDER ONE NEEDED A STORY SO I, WELL AND SHE WAS WATCHING
261 T.V. SO UM SO I DID IT.

274 EM: SO YOU'RE SAYING ABOUT 9:30, 10:00 O'CLOCK MAYBE?
275 JP: WELL I COULD OF SWORN IT WAS EARLIER THAN THAT BUT
276 EM: OKAY
277 JP: UM WELL MAYBE NOT EARLIER THAN 9:30 YEAH PROBABLY 9:30
278 EM: OKAY ALRIGHTALRIGHT THEN WHAT HAPPENED AFTER THAT
279 WHAT DID YA DO AFTER THAT?
280 JP: UM SHE WANTED ME TO CLEAN THE COUCH SO I DID AND THEN AH
281 WE WATCHED
282 EM: WHAT DO YOU MEAN BY CLEAN THE COUCH?

300 JP: UM...AND TAKING THE BOYS TO DO SMORES MAINLY.....SO WE
301 COULD DO SOME MORNING SMORES YOU KNOW?
302 EM: UM HUH OKAY AND THEN YOU SAY SHE WENT TO BED?

304 EM: THEN WHAT DID YA DO AFTER THAT?
305 JP: LOADED UP THE CAR AND.....UM LOADED UP THE BOYS AND DROVE
306 OFF
307 EM: SO YOU WOKE THEM UP? LOADED THEM UP WHAT TIME WAS THAT?
308 JP: WELL I MEAN IT WASN'T I WOULDN'T SAY I WOKE THEM UP I JUST
309 TRANSFERRED THEM.
310 EM: DID SHE KNOW THAT YOU WERE GOING TO DO SMORES?
311 JP: YEAH
312 EM: SHE DID! SHE KNEW YOU WERE TAKING THE KIDS?
313 JP: YEAH
314 EM: WHAT TIME DID YOU LEAVE THE HOUSE?
315 JP: IT SEEMS LIKE 1:30 OR 2:00
316 EM: OKAY AND WHAT DID YOU LOAD UP INTO THE, INTO THE VAN?
317 JP: UM WELL.....3 PAIRS OF CLOTHES FOR EACH KID SOMETHING LIKE
318 THAT AND.....THE GENERATOR, HEATERS, AH LEFT THE SLEDS IN
319 THERE CAUSE I FIGURED WE MIGHT BE ABLE TO USE THEM

321 JP: I MEAN I DON'T KNOW JUST A BUNCH OF STUF YOU KNOW
322 EM: OKAY
323 JP: UM.....A LITTLE PILE OF WOOD
324 EM: OKAY
325 JP: A LIGHTER YOU KNOW ALL THAT KIND OF STUFF

327 JP: UM.....I MEAN

329 JP: I DON'T KNOW JUST WHATEVERS APPROPRIATE YOU KNOW.

331 JP: UM WELL I STARTED HEADING SOUTH THROUGH TOOEELE AND JUST
332 TURNED ONTO THE PONY EXPRESS
333 EM: UM HUH AND THAT'S HOW FAR DOWN THE PONY EXPRESS DID YOU

335 JP: NOT VERY FAR...MAYBE 20 MILES I DON'T KNOW
336 EM: TWENTY MILES ON THE PONY EXPRESS?
337 JP: MAYBE
338 EM: OKAY, DID YA STOP AND ON THE SIDE OF THE ROAD OR STAY ON
339 THE ROAD WHEN YOU WENT DOWN THERE? IS THAT WHERE YOU
340 JUST DROVE STRAIGHT TO FROM YOUR HOUSE?
341 JP: PRETTY MUCH YEAH
342 EM: PRETTY MUCH, WHERE'D YA STOP INBETWEEN?
343 JP: WELL I MEAN NO THAT'S IT
344 EM: WELL PRETTY MUCH I MEAN IT'S
345 JP: SORRY!
346 EM: I MEAN PRETTY MUCH MEANS YOU STOPPED SOME WHERE ELSE SO.
347 JP: NO I, I, I JUST WENT STRAIGHT THERE
348 EM: YOU DROVE STRAIGHT TO THE PONY EXPRESS, OKAY. SO WHEN
349 YOU GOT TO YOUR DESTINATION TWENTY MILES POSSIBLY
350 TWENTY MILES DOWN THE PONY EXPRESS WHAT A DID YOU JUST
351 STAY ON THE ROAD, DID YOU PULL OFF ON THE SIDE OF THE ROAD?
352 JP: NO THEY HAVE TRAILS THAT YOU CAN DRIVE ON AND
353 EM: UM HUH
354 JP: I MEAN I JUST FOUND ONE
355 EM: HOW FAR UP THE TRAIL DID YA GO?
356 JP: LIKE I DON'T KNOW A MILE OR SOMETHING I DON'T KNOW
357 EM: WHICH DIRECTION?
358 JP: UM....LEFT TIL I GUESS SOUTH THE PONY EXPRESS IS EAST, WEST I
359 DON'T REALLY KNOW
360 EM: SO ONCE YOU GOT THERE WHAT DID YA DO?
