To be honest, I really don't know that much about Susan and Josh. I served with Susan in the Young Women's program in our ward not long after they had moved into the neighborhood, but not very closely or for very long. The only thing I know about her relationship with Josh is the stuff I've heard from other people - which as I'm sure you know, has not been good. There was only ONE instance I heard/saw something first-hand and that was an email sent to me quite a long time ago from Susan stating something along the lines of, "Please pray and fast for me as I am debating on whether or not to leave Josh, and will be going to the Temple to try to get an answer to this question." To be completely honest, I really can't even remember if the email was sent to me by Susan herself or if someone had forwarded it to me. I also know that Susan was a very vocal person - not really super private about things. In relief society she would openly talk about matters that I thought were personal, [REDACTED] I did not attend relief society very often or frequently (she was in the presidency at the time she disappeared), but the times I did go, she seemed like the type of person that was not very private, even about what seemed could be private matters.

I never had a conversation with Josh, I thought he was very strange. I only saw him at church or walking around the neighborhood with Susan and [REDACTED] But, through the years Josh stopped going to church, and I didn't see them walking in the neighborhood as much. One summer a few years ago, we were having a big family barbeque in our back yard. All of my family were just relaxing and talking and the kids were running around and playing. Josh and Susan were over at the [REDACTED] and Josh stuck his head over the fence and watched our family party for about five or ten minutes until my Dad noticed and asked Josh if he needed something. Josh then asked if he could borrow our shovel (or some other yard tool) and tried to make small talk with some of my family. My family was kind of creeped out by him just sitting and watching us and interrupting our family get-together.
