6 EM: OKAY 10/19.....  
7 AO: SO IS THIS LIKE YOUR OFFICE OR JUST LIKE A PROCESSING ROOM?  
8 EM: JUST AN INTERVIEW ROOM IS ALL IT IS. IT'D BE A PRETTY SAD  
9 OFFICE WOULDN'T IT?  
10 AO: I KNOW IT'S LIKE WHERE ARE THE WINDOWS, WHERE'S THE VIEW.  
11 EM: WELL I DON'T GET A WINDOW IN MY LITTLE CUBICLE BUT WELL  
12 OKAY SO, WHAT IS YOUR ADDRESS?  
13 AO: UM [REDACTED]  
14 EM: ALRIGHT AND YOU'RE THE SON OF [REDACTED] RIGHT?  
15 AO: (INAUDIBLE)  
16 EM: NOW I DON'T KNOW HOW TO SPELL IT YOUR MOM YESTERDAY  
17 SHE'D MENTIONED THAT YOU HAD BABYSAT FOR THEM THE  
18 SATURDAY PRIOR?  
19 AO: UM HUH.  
20 EM: SO THAT WOULD HAVE BEEN THE 5<sup>TH</sup>?  
21 AO: YEAH  
22 EM: RIGHT YEAH. UM....SO YOU'RE FAMILIAR AND YOU KNOW SUSAN  
23 AND JOSH POWELL?  
24 AO: YEAH.  
25 EM: OKAY SO UM HAD YOU BEEN, HAD YOU BEEN OVER TO THEIR HOME  
26 BEFORE PRIOR TO THE 5<sup>TH</sup>?

27 AO: YES.

28 EM: HOW MANY TIMES PRIOR?

29 AO: ONCE OR TWICE.

30 EM: OKAY...AND WHY DID YOU GO OVER THERE?

31 AO: UM FRIDAY ABOUT BLACK FRIDAY NOT FRIDAY THE 13<sup>TH</sup>

32 EM: YEAH BUT, BUT

33 AO: THAT FRIDAY.

34 EM: YEAH BUT WHAT DID YOU GO OVER THERE FOR?

35 AO: THE TWO LITTLE BABIES THAT WERE THEIR KIDS.

36 EM: OKAY SO YOU BABYSAT THEIR CHILDREN

37 AO: YEAH.

38 EM: UM ONE OR TWO TIMES PRIOR TO THIS

39 AO: YES.

40 EM: THE 5<sup>TH</sup>? OH OKAY.....ALRIGHT..AND WHO IS IT THAT ASKED YOU TO

41 BABYSIT FOR THEM WAS IT JOSH OR SUSAN?

42 AO: UM BOTH.

43 EM: OKAY ALRIGHT, AND UM WHEN YOU THE THREE, THE ONE OR

44 THREE TIMES THAT YOU BABY, OR WHAT SO YOU BABYSAT FOR

45 THEM FOR LIKE TWO OR THREE TIMES?

46 AO: YEAH.

47 EM: SO THE TWO OR THREE TIMES UM THAT YOU BABYSAT FOR THEM

48 UM YOU BABYSAT BOTH CHILDREN [REDACTED] AND?

49 AO: YES.

50 EM: [REDACTED]?

51 AO: [REDACTED]!

52 EM: YEAH UM WAS THERE ANY OTHER ADULTS IN THE HOUSE WHEN

53 YOU WERE THERE TO BABYSIT?

54 AO: (TWO PEOPLE TALKING AT ONCE)

55 EM: I MEAN WAS JOSH HOME?

56 AO: (INAUDIBLE) YEAH

57 EM: OR WOULD THEY BOTH BE GONE FROM THE HOUSE?

58 AO: USUALLY THEIR BOTH GONE OR WHY WOULD THEY NEED A  
59 BABYSITTER?

60 EM: OH OKAY, ALRIGHT AND WAS THERE ANYTHING OF CONCERNS OR  
61 ANYTHING THAT STROKE YOU AS BEING ODD WHEN YOU BABYSAT  
62 THERE THE FIRST COUPLE OF TIMES?

63 AO: UM...NOT REALLY.

64 EM: OKAY UM ON THIS LAST TIME ON SATURDAY THE 5<sup>TH</sup> WAS THERE  
65 ANYTHING OF INTEREST OR THAT WAS ODD OR THAT UM

66 AO: WELL

67 EM: THAT GAVE YOU CONCERN?

68 AO: WHEN, WHEN SUSAN GOT HOME SHE SEEMED A LITTLE BIT MORE  
69 UPSET AND GRUMPY ABOUT SOMETHING.

70 EM: UM HUH, OKAY, WHAT TIME DID YOU GET OVER THERE ON  
71 SATURDAY?

72 AO: I WAS THERE FROM 1:00 P.M. UNTIL...AROUND 10:00 TO 11:00 P.M.

73 EM: OKAY.

74 AO: WE CAME OVER AT 1:00 AND LIKE I WAS HELPING HIM IN HIS  
75 GARAGE AND STUFF WE WERE DOING SOME WOOD WORKING

76 EM: UM HUH.

77 AO: AND STUFF LIKE THAT.....AND

78 EM: FOR HOW LONG?

79 AO: UM ABOUT FIVE HOURS UNTL 6:00.

80 EM: OKAY SO YOU WERE OVER THERE FROM 1:00 TO 6:00 WITH JOSH?

81 AO: AH HUH.

82 EM: YOU GUYS WERE DOING WOOD WORKING STUFF IN THE GARAGE?

83 AO: YEAH.

84 EM: OKAY, WAS THERE ANYTHING THAT WAS SAID TO YOU THAT, THAT  
85 YOU THOUGHT WAS INTERESTING OR THAT YOU THOUGHT WAS  
86 ODD OR LIKE PUT ANY CONCERN OR ANYTHING THAT YOU GUYS  
87 DID IN THAT TIME FRAME?

88 AO: NO IT SEEMED PRETTY NORMAL TO ME.

89 EM: OH OKAY, ALRIGHT SO WHY ARE YOU HERE TO SEE ME TODAY?  
90 AO: BECAUSE LIKE HIS WHOLE CAMPING THING AND THE CARPET  
91 BEING SHAMPOOED LIKE THAT'S ALL FROM SATURDAYISH. ON  
92 SATURADAY WE WORKED ON A PERSONAL GENERATOR THAT HE  
93 HAD SO HE PROBABLY WANTED TO TAKE THAT FOR A TEST RUN  
94 THAT'S PROBABLY WHY HE WENT CAMPING.  
95 EM: UM HUH.  
96 AO: AND WHILE WE WERE WORKING ON THE THING WE WERE PUTTING  
97 LIKE OIL AND GASOLINE ON IT AND THAT GOT ON OUR SHOES AND I  
98 WALKED ON HIS CARPET WITH MY SHOES ON SO  
99 EM: UM HUH.  
100 AO: THAT'S PROBABLY WHY HE SHAMPOOED THE CARPET.  
101 EM: OKAY ALRIGHT, ANYTHING ELSE?  
102 AO: NO THAT'S PRETTY MUCH IT  
103 EM: OH OKAY, SO THAT'S ALL YOU WANTED TO SHARE WITH ME IS, IS  
104 THAT AND THAT AH SUSAN WAS KIND OF GRUMPY WHEN SHE GOT  
105 HOME.  
106 AO: YEAH. JOSH IS A PRETTY LIKE HE'S RANDOM AND WHEN HE GETS  
107 AN IDEA HE ACTS ON IT  
108 EM: UM HUH.  
109 AO: SO LIKE IF HE DECIDED HEY LET'S GO CAMPING HE MORE THAN  
110 LIKELY JUST GO CAMPING.  
111 EM: UM HUH.  
112 AO: DESPITE AND THEN HE'D THINK ABOUT IT LATER AND BE LIKE  
113 WAIT WHAT THINGS (INAUDIBLE).  
114 EM: UM HUH.  
115 AO: THAT SORT OF THING.  
116 EM: OKAY.....DESCRIBE THAT GENERATOR TO ME?  
117 AO: UM IT'S A YAMAHA, IT'S SMALL, BLUE, IT'S GOT A GRAY PLASTIC  
118 BACK PANEL THAT YOU HAVE TO UNSCREW AND PULL OFF TO PUT  
119 OIL IN IT.

120 EM: OKAY....WHEN SUSAN GOT HOME YOU SAID SHE WAS A LITTLE  
121 GRUMPY, DID THEY GET INTO ANY SORT OF AN ARGUMENT OR  
122 DISCUSSION?

123 AO: SHE WAS MAINLY ANGRY AT THE KIDS CAUSE THEY WEREN'T IN  
124 BED SO.

125 EM: CAUSE OF WHAT?

126 AO: CAUSE THEY WEREN'T IN BED SHE WAS PROBABLY REALLY TIRED  
127 AND GRUMPY. AS FAR AS I'M, AS FAR AS I CAN TELL THERE  
128 WEREN'T ANY WORDS SAID BETWEEN HER AND JOSH WHILE I WAS  
129 THERE.

130 EM: RIGHT.....ANYTHING ELSE YOU CAN THINK OF THAT YOU THINK  
131 WOULD BE IMPORTANT FOR ME TO KNOW, MAYBE I DIDN'T ASK YA  
132 THE RIGHT QUESTION?

133 AO: NO NOT ONE I CAN THINK OF GOT IT ALL DOWN.

134 EM: OKAY.....YOU SAY HE POSSIBLY CLEANED THE CARPETS CAUSE  
135 YOU GOT OIL ON THE CARPET?

136 AO: OIL AND OR GASOLINE ON IT AND IT PROBABLY SMELLED LIKE IT  
137 TO CAUSE IT KIND OF SMELLED LIKE IT WHEN I LEFT AH THEN THAT  
138 COULD HAVE BEEN FROM THE GARAGE CAUSE WE HAD SOME  
139 STUFF IN THERE...

140 EM: OKAY....ALRIGHT IS THERE ANYTHING ELSE YOU CAN THINK OF?

141 AO: NOPE.

142 EM: ALRIGHTY OKAY ANY QUESTIONS? ANYTHING, DO YOU KNOW, DID  
143 YOU KNOW SUSAN AT ALL? I MEAN HOW WELL DID YA KNOW HER?

144 AO: WE HAD BRIEF CONVERSATIONS ABOUT THE KIDS AND IF THIS  
145 HAPPENS DO THIS

146 EM: UM HUH.

147 AO: THAT SORT OF THING.

148 EM: OKAY UM SUSAN EVER SAY ANYTHING TO YOU THAT YOU  
149 THOUGHT WAS INTERESTING OR AH OR ODD OR OF ANY CONCERN  
150 WHEN YOU'D GO THERE TO BABYSIT BEFORE THEY LEAVE?

151 AO: NO.

152 EM: NO? OKAY.....UM YOU HAVE ANY IDEA WHERE SHE MIGHT BE OR  
153 WHAT HAD HAPPENED?

154 AO: I DON'T KNOW THERE'S A LOT OF SPECULATION AND A LOT OF  
155 STUFF THAT GOES AROUND.

156 EM: RIGHT.

157 AO: PERSONALLY LIKE...I KIND OF SWAY FROM ONE SIDE TO THE  
158 OTHER BECAUSE THERE'S STUFF THAT COULD HAPPEN BUT UM I'D  
159 LIKE TO SAY THAT ME AND JOSH ARE PRETTY COOL AND HE  
160 DOESN'T SEEM LIKE THE TYPE OF GUY THAT WOULD BE ABLE TO  
161 KILL SOMEBODY.

162 EM: RIGHT. DO YOU THINK SHE'S ALIVE OR DEAD?

163 AO: I DON'T KNOW BUT MY MOM SAYS THAT HER DAD SAID THAT HE'S  
164 NOT TOO WORRIED ABOUT IT AND I THINK THAT IF HER DAD'S NOT  
165 WORRIED ABOUT IT HE MIGHT KNOW SOMETHING ABOUT IT SO.

166 EM: UM HUH.

167 AO: MAYBE SHE IS ALIVE MAYBE SHE GOT ON A PLANE WENT DOWN  
168 THERE.

169 EM: OKAY ANY IDEA OF IF SHE HAD ANY PROBLEMS WITH ANYBODY?

170 AO: UM, NO I DON'T REALLY THINK SO.

171 EM: ANY ENEMIES? OKAY, ALRIGHT OKAY (INAUDIBLE) ANYTHING  
172 ELSE?

173 AO: OH NO THAT'S PRETTY MUCH IT.

174 EM: OKAY WELL THANKS FOR COMING DOWN WITH YOUR MOM ALEX.

175 AO: YEAH. (THE DOOR OPENS AND CLOSES)
