108 EM: UM ON SOME WEEKS TWICE A WEEK IF YOU GUYS WERE GOING

110 EM: MEET FOR THE CROCHET, UM ANY OTHER TIMES THAT YOU WOULD
111 MEET UM
112 JO: SHE UM
113 EM: (INAUDIBLE)

114 JO: SHE CALLED ME UM A COUPLE OF TIMES TO UM COME AND HELP
115 HER UM ONE TIME SHE CALLED ME TO UM COME AND GET HER AND
116 GO PICK UP HER CHILDREN

117 EM: UM HUH

118 JO: BECAUSE JOSH WAS SUPPOSE TO BE HOME AND THIS WAS, THIS
119 WAS JUST BEFORE THANKSGIVING TO BECAUSE JOSH WAS SUPPOSE
120 TO BE HOME AND HE WAS LATE AND THE KIDS NEEDED TO BE
121 PICKED UP FROM DAY CARE SO AND THEY ONLY HAD THE ONE
122 VEHICLE, SO I WENT OVER AND PICKED HER UP AND THEN SHE
123 SHOWED ME WHERE THE DAY CARE WAS AND WE PICKED UP THE

149 JO: SO UM.....AND THEN THE SATURDAY AFTER THANKSGIVING AND
150 THEN THIS LAST SATURDAY AND SUNDAY, AH I'VE PROBABLY
151 BEEN INSIDE THE HOME AH FOUR TIMES
152 EM: OKAY, ALRIGHT
153 JO: MAYBE FIVE
154 EM: ALRIGHT, SO MAYBE IN THE HOME FOUR OR FIVE TIMES
155 JO: CORRECT
156 EM: UM YOU'D SPENT SOME TIME THERE
157 JO: YES
158 EM: BUT ON THE OTHER HAND YOU'VE UM HOW OFTEN WOULD YOU
159 SAY WOULD YOU SPEAK TO SUSAN SAY WHEN YOU COULD I MEAN
160 WOULD IT BE ONCE A WEEK, THREE TIMES A WEEK ON AVERAGE?
161 JO: UM PROBABLY TWICE A WEEK
162 EM: OKAY....ALRIGHT PERFECT. I KNOW I'M DOING THIS KIND JUST
163 KIND OF LAYING SOME GROUND WORK JUST TO KIND OF ESTABLISH

170 KNOW YOU GUYS WENT TO CHURCH RIGHT? YOU GUYS WENT TO

193 TO EAT AND THEN SUNDAY'S ARE KIND OF MY CALMING QUIET
194 LEAVE ME ALONE DAY BECAUSE IT'S WHEN I SLEEP OR JUST AH
195 CATCH UP ON YOUR (INAUDIBLE) WHATEVER I HAVEN'T SEEN
196 BECAUSE I'VE BEEN TOO TIRED RUNNING AROUND OR DOING
197 WHATEVER DURING THE WEEK SO I ACTUALLY WAS GETTING

206 EM: OKAY AND BEFORE WE GO UM RIGHT THERE...THERE'S ONE THING I
207 REMEMBER THAT I HAD A QUESTION ABOUT IS WHAT TIME DID
208 STATE CONFERENCE, WHAT TIME DID CHURCH START, WHAT TIME
209 DID IT START?
210 JO: IT WAS 10:00 TO 12:00
211 EM: OKAY SO 10:00
212 JO: THAT DAY IT WAS 10:00 TO 12:00
213 EM: TO 12:00 WAS THE TIMES FOR STATE CONFERENCE
214 JO: YEAH
215 EM: WOULD HAVE BEEN PERFECT SO SHE CALLS YOU POSSIBLY
216 AROUND 2:00 O'CLOCK?
217 JO: RIGHT BECAUSE I'D HAD ENOUGH TIME TO GET HOME AND GET
218 CALM AND START THINKING OH I THINK I'M GONNA JUST KIND OF
219 CRAWL IN BED AND GET WARM AND WATCH A MOVIE AND JUST
220 KIND OF YOU KNOW LIKE YOU KNOW?

231 UM.....INTERESTING OKAY BUT I MAY GET SOME PHONE CALLS
232 INBETWEEN IF IT'S SOMETHING I CAN IGNORE I WILL AND I MIGHT
233 BE GETTING SOME TEXT CAUSE I TOLD SOME PEOPLE THAT I'M

244 HELPED HER WITH AH HER YARN SHE'D GET IT TANGLED UP AND SO
245 I'D HELP HER UNTANGLE HER YARN AND PUT IT IN BALLS AND
246 STUFF SO IT'S EASIER FOR HER TO WORK WITH, BUT UM IT HAD
247 BECOME TANGLED AGAIN AND SHE WAS VERY FRUSTRATED WITH
248 IT AND SHE DIDN'T REALLY WANT TO CUT IT

324 JO: OH YEAH BECAUSE ALL I REALLY HAD TO DO WAS JUST PUT SOME
325 STUFF ON AND JUST GO AND I JUST PUT ON MY SLIP ON SHOES
326 BECAUSE I KNEW I WAS GONNA TAKE THEM OFF WHEN I GOT THERE
327 AND I WASN'T GONNA PUT ON MY HIGH UPS (INAUDIBLE) AND AH
328 SO I TOOK OFF MY COAT, TOOK OFF MY SHOES
329 EM: OKAY
330 JO: WALKED IN SAT DOWN AND LOOKED AT THE MESS SHE HAD AND
331 SHE HAD IT REAL BAD
332 EM: (LAUGH, LAUGH)
333 JO: STARTED WORKING ON IT AND WE STARTED TALKING AND WE
334 TALKED ABOUT I MEAN WE TALKED ABOUT ALL KINDS OF THINGS,
335 WE UM AND SHE HAD TOLD ME AH SOME THINGS EARLIER ABOUT
336 HER LIFE AH WHEN I GUESS WHEN THEY WERE FIRST MARRIED
337 THEY LIVED WITH HER FATHER-IN-LAW AND AH

1334 KNOWING THEM

1335 JO: WHAT THE ONLY THING

1336 EM: HOW DO THEY GET TO WORK?

1337 JO: I KNOW IS WHAT, WHAT I THINK HAPPENS EVERY SATURDAY IS
1338 THAT ON SATURDAY HE TAKES HER TO WORK ON SATURDAY AND
1339 PICKS HER UP FROM WORK

1340 EM: ON SATURDAYS?

1341 JO: ON SATURDAYS, SO I'M ASSUMING THAT, THAT'S WHAT HE DOES
1342 EVERY DAY WHEN SHE GOES TO WORK IS TAKES HER TO WORK
1343 AND PICKS HER UP. I DON'T KNOW THAT'S TRUE

1344 EM: SO EVEN THOUGH HE'S HOME ON SATURDAY'S HE STILL TAKES HER
1345 AND DROPS HER OFF SHE DOESN'T TAKE HER OWN VEHICLE?

1346 JO: RIGHT NO, BECAUSE ON SATURDAYS HE TAKES THE BOYS UM TO
1347 AH WOOD WORKING AH WORK SHOPS AT HOME DEPOT AND LOWES
1348 TO MAKE WOOD WORKING PROJECTS AND SO HE HAS TO HAVE THE
1349 VEHICLE TO DO THAT.

1350 EM: BUT I THOUGHT YOU WERE AT HOME, AT THEIR HOME

1351 JO: I KEEP

1352 EM: AH WATCHING THEM?

1353 JO: YEAH USUALLY ABOUT NOON OR SO I GO OVER
1354 EM: OH YOU GO OVER THERE ABOUT NOON ON SATURDAYS?
1355 JO: YEAH
1356 EM: OKAY
1357 JO: I DON'T LIKE TO MAKE IT EARLY.....SO I'M NOT LIKE THERE ALL
1358 DAY I'M THERE MAYBE FOUR OR FIVE HOURS.
1359 EM: I'VE GOT YA, SO YOU ONLY, YOU ONLY KNOW THAT HE TAKES HER
1360 AND DROPS HER OFF ON SATURDAYS, BUT YOU ASSUME THAT
1361 THAT'S WHAT THE SAME PRACTICE IS DURING THE WEEK?
1362 JO: RIGHT AND I
1363 EM: HAS SHE EVER EXPRESSED THAT TO YOU?
1364 JO: NO
1365 EM: OR EXPRESSED ON HOW SHE GETS TO WORK?
1366 JO: NO BUT I KNOW THAT HE IS SUPPOSE TO PICK THE BOYS UP FROM,
1367 THAT HE WAS SUPPOSE TO PICK THE BOYS UP FROM DAY CARE AND
1368 THAT'S WHY SHE CALLED ME BECAUSE HE WAS STUCK IN TRAFFIC
1369 AND COULDN'T PICK THE BOYS UP FROM DAY CARE AND SO I HAD

1421 JO: AND AH FLITS FROM THING AND AH AND YOU KNOW IT JUST LIKES
1422 ON A SUBJECT AND THEN GOES TO ANOTHER SUBJECT AND GOES
1423 TO ANOTHER SUBJECT AND GOES OVER HERE AND
1424 EM: OKAY
1425 JO: SO AND I UNDERSTAND IT BECAUSE I HAVE KIDS LIKE THAT SO I
1426 CAN FOLLOW IT
1427 EM: UM HUH.
1428 JO: AND SO IT DOESN'T BOTHER ME, SO I'M JUST LIKE OH YEAH OKAY
1429 I'VE GOT ONE, SO I GO WITH IT
1430 EM: OKAY
1431 JO: SO IT DOESN'T BOTHER ME AT ALL AND I'M JUST LIKE OKAY I CAN
1432 GET INTO THAT ROUTINE I'LL GET THAT ONE. UM AND BUT UM AND,
1433 AND BECAUSE IT'S SO NORMAL FOR ME I DON'T NOTICE IT ANY

1460 JO: AND IT BECAUSE I'VE BEEN

1461 EM: HAVE THEY SPOKEN OR WAS THERE ANY DISCUSSION ABOUT IT
1462 REAL ESTATE AND SELLING HOUSE?

1463 JO: UM HIS WIFE SAID HE USE TO BE A REAL ESTATE AGENT BUT DIDN'T
1464 MAKE MONEY.

1465 EM: OKAY (TWO PEOPLE TALKING AT ONCE)

1466 JO: COULDN'T MAKE MONEY

1467 EM: THEY DIDN'T SPEAK, THEY DIDN'T NEVER SPEAK ABOUT HIM
1468 CURRENTLY SELLING ANY HOMES

1469 JO: NO

1470 EM: OR ANYTHING LIKE THAT?

1471 JO: NO

1472 EM: OKAY

1473 JO: I DON'T KNOW WHAT HE DOES.

1474 EM: OKAY THERE WAS QUITE A FEW COMPUTERS IN THE HOME DO YOU
1475 FROM YOUR EXPERIENCE IN BEING IN THE RESIDENCE IF AH WHO
1476 WOULD SPEND TIME ON THE COMPUTER IF ANYBODY DID?
1477 JO: UM SUSAN SAID THAT SHE WATCHED UM...I THINK IT'S EITHER
1478 C.S.I. OR N.C.I.S. I CAN'T REMEMBER WHICH ONE IN THE
1479 AFTERNOONS IN HER MASSAGE CHAIR WHEN THE BOYS HAD THEIR
1480 NAPS THAT WAS HER BIG THRILL (LAUGH, LAUGH) AND UM I EDIT

1493 ABOUT THAT BECAUSE HE WOULD PUT THEM ON HIS COMPUTER
1494 AND UM SHE DIDN'T HAVE ACCESS TO THEM BECAUSE HE HAD A
1495 PASSWORD OR SOMETHING ON IT
1496 EM: UM HUH

1497 JO: AND SHE DIDN'T HAVE ACCESS TO IT AND ALSO EVEN IF SHE DID
1498 SHE COULDN'T PRINT THEM OUT BECAUSE HE WOULDN'T SET UP A
1499 PRINTER TO PRINT OUT THE PICTURES OF HER AND THE KIDS AND
1500 YOU KNOW ALL THE PICTURES THAT THEY'D TAKEN. UM LIKE THE

1522 OF COMPUTERS THERE PROBABLY ALL JOSH'S.

1523 EM: OKAY, UM....

1524 JO: I DO KNOW HE'S AH, AH LOOKING A BUNCH OF WOOD ALL OVER
1525 THAT HOUSE.

1526 EM: YEAH

1527 JO: DOWNSTAIRS EVERY WHERE AND HE TOLD ME WHEN HE TOOK ME
1528 AND ALEX AND SHOWED US THE DOWNSTAIRS HE SAYS THAT
1529 MOSTLY FOR THE DECK AND I'M JUST THINKING, "BULL CRAP", BUT
1530 YOU KNOW I DIDN'T SAY ANYTHING AND, AND I'M LOOKING AT

1561 EM: ALRIGHT UM...IS THERE ANYTHING ELSE YOU CAN THINK OF?
1562 JO: IF I DO I'LL WRITE IT DOWN. UM...HUH...
1563 EM: IS THERE AH ANYTHING THINGS YOU HAVE CONCERNS DO YOU
1564 HAVE ANY CONCERNS THAT YOU THINK I SHOULD KNOW ABOUT?
1565 JO: I JUST I HONESTLY I WOULD REALLY LIKE TO TALK TO JOSH AND
1566 TALK TO THE KIDS AND JUST SEE HOW THINGS ARE GOING BUT
1567 EM: OKAY
1568 JO: YOU KNOW I DON'T KNOW WHY DO YOU WANT ME TO DO THAT OR?
1569 EM: WELL YOU KNOW WE CAN'T STOP YOU FROM
1570 JO: WELL I KNOW YOU CAN'T STOP
1571 EM: I MEAN FROM TALKING TO HIM IS NOT UM...UM...I GUESS IS

1582 KNOW MAKE CONTACT WITH HIM JUST TO SIMPLY SEE HOW HE IS
1583 DOING AND YOU KNOW IF THERE IS ANYTHING YOU CAN DO TO
1584 OFFER IT YOU KNOW HELP HIM TO YOU KNOW IN THIS TIME OF
1585 NEED I MEAN SUSAN IS STILL MISSING, WE DON'T KNOW WHERE
1586 SHE'S AT UM NOBODY KNOWS WHERE SHE'S AT NOBODY KNOWS
1587 ANYTHING. SO UM I WOULD THINK THAT AH YOU KNOW THAT

1598 THAT. AS FAR AS THE PRESS THOUGH YOU BROUGHT THAT UP
1599 EARLIER UM...IN SPEAKING WITH THE PRESS THE, BASICALLY
1600 GENERALLY IS WHAT UM WE'RE GONNA LET THE PRESS KNOW YOU
1601 KNOW HOW THE INVESTIGATIONS GOING THE MEDIA CAN BE VERY

1615 EM: SO THE LESS PEOPLE THAT KNOW WHAT'S GOING ON THE EASIER IT
1616 IS FOR THE INVESTIGATION. LIKE FOR EXAMPLE WHEN WE SAT
1617 DOWN UM YOU KNOW AND I EXPLAINED TO YOU AH THAT YOU
1618 KNOW I JUST WANT TO HEAR WHAT YOU KNOW FROM THEM, WHAT
1619 YOU'VE HEARD FROM THEM, WHAT YOU'VE SEEN FIRST HAND AND
1620 THAT'S WHERE IT KIND OF CAN AFFECT THE INVESTIGATION IS
1621 BECAUSE I MEAN YOU KNOW AS WELL AS I DO EVERYBODY OUT
1622 THERE ALL THE BOARD MEMBERS THAT KNOW HIM, ALL THE
1623 CLOSE THE FRIENDS EVERYBODY'S TALKING, SOME PEOPLE KNOW

1629 JO: SEE, BUT, BUT I HAVE KIND OF A, I HAVE KIND A UNI- UNIQUE AH
1630 PERSPECTIVE IN THAT HONESTLY FOR THE LAST YEAR I'VE BEEN
1631 DEPRESSED SO I'VE REALLY BEEN ISOLATED AND SO I HAVEN'T
1632 BEEN PAYING ATTENTION TO WHAT'S GOING TO (INAUDIBLE)

1633 EM: AND YEAH

1634 JO: I'VE REALLY HAD A VERY UNIQUE POSITION

1635 EM: AND YOU'RE PRETTY CRITICAL IN, IN THIS INVESTIGATION UM IF
1636 YOUR

1637 JO: I'M PRETTY CRITICAL ANY WAYS (LAUGH, LAUGH) IT WORKS
1638 GREAT

1639 EM: YEAH SO I MEAN FOR OBVIOUS REASONS YOU'RE THE LAST ONE TO,
1640 TO SEE HER BESIDES JOSH UM YOU WERE THERE AH FOR A FEW
1641 HOURS SO YOU KNOW OBVIOUSLY IF THE MEDIA KNOWS THAT
1642 THEIR GONNA REALLY DRILL YOU AS TO HOW

1643 JO: THAT'S WHY I WANT TO STAY AWAY FROM THEM
1644 EM: WHAT YOU'VE SEEN, WHAT YOU HEARD AND THEIR GONNA
1645 OBVIOUSLY DIVE INTO THEIR MARITAL PROBLEMS THEY WANT TO
1646 YOU KNOW
1647 JO: I KNOW WHAT THEY WANT ME

1648 EM: THEY WANT, WANT, WANT SO YOU KNOW I'M NOT SAYING THAT
1649 YOU CAN OR CAN NOT TALK TO THE PRESS IF YOU CHOSE TO TALK
1650 TO THEM MY REQUEST IS THAT YOU JUST YOU KNOW I MEAN
1651 OBVIOUSLY IS WHAT THIS IS OUR GOAL IS TO FIND HER AND IS
1652 WHAT THIS INVESTIGATION IS, IS A MISSING PERSON SO IF YOU

1690 KNOW WHY

1716 ANYTHING THAT YOU CAN THINK OF THAT YOU THINK MAYBE AH
1717 GOOD INFORMATION FOR US OR SOME CRITICAL INFORMATION
1718 PLEASE GIVE ME A CALL, YOU GOT MY NUMBERS?

1748 WITH ME IF AH DID I GIVE YOU MY CARD I'M SURE I DID?

1749 JO: I DON'T THINK I HAVE YOUR CARD BUT I HAVE A

1750 EM: UM A FEW OF US DO IF THERE'S ANYTHING ELSE YOU HEAR OR

1754 JO: TEXT YOU ON MY LITTLE SPIT PHONE.

1771 EM: THAT UM THAT I SHOULD RESPOND TO QUICKLY YOU AT THAT
