After completing a work project with Offender Nielsen #313504 at 1530, Steve came into my office and I asked how he was doing. He seemed preoccupied with the day's events as he shared the challenges of addressing the news media. During our conversation he said a reporter asked him a question concerning a photograph he had sent his daughter-in-law Susan. Steve said that if Susan hadn't been "OK" with the picture she wouldn't have "accepted it". Steve did not mention the identity of the reporter or the content of the photo.

Although I do not remember his specific remarks, Steve alluded to an apparent attraction between him and his daughter-in-law Susan. Concerned with potential "boundary" issues, I pursued the possibility of restricting Steve's access to WCCW on a temporary basis.

Steve's workload had not required him to return to WCCW. August 24th was Steve's last visit to the CI Design Services Department.

Immediate Action Taken: I spoke with CI Management the next morning regarding the possible temporary restriction of Steve's access to WCCW. Management was already working proactively on Steve's situation.
