I am four months away from being released. I need help finding a place to live. If I can't get help from you, or can't communicate with you, I may go back to the idea of moving back to the house. I will tell the DOC that anyone who is not comfortable with that arrangement will vacate.

Also, I will need about \$1000 to set up if I move into an apartment, so I will need to borrow some money from that source I let you use a few weeks ago. So don't take any more out without my say so.

I hope you and John will visit me when the weather is OK. Don't come over if it's in the low 30s. I don't need to add traffic worries to my anxieties.

If you can get me the autobiography of Parley P. Pratt I would like that. Don't bother with the other books I requested. I will consult my own copies at home when I get out.

My appellate attorney has not yet filed a brief in my behalf. She will probably do it in 60 days. That was what I understood from her in December.

I found some information in the law library that there is a 3-year Statute of limitation on filing a wrongful death suit. I would still like to get that ruling immediately. I think it will help us all the way around. So please help me with the letters I requested.
