25 WOULD YOU SPEAK WITH HER OVER THE PHONE OR SEE HER IN PERSON?

26 ■ UM WE EXCHANGED A FEW E-MAILS AND UM I WATCHED HER BOYS A
27 COUPLE OF TIMES SO I UM AND WE ACTUALLY HAD A FEW GIRLS NIGHT
28 OUTS UM WITH SOME GIRLS IN THE WARD, BUT I'D SAY MAYBE ONCE OR
29 TWICE A MONTH.

30 EM: OKAY....SORRY I'M JUST KIND OF TAKING NOTES AS WE SPEAK.

31 ■ THAT'S OKAY ■

32 EM: AND UM.....AS FAR AS THE E-MAILS EXCHANGED AND THE E-MAILS AND
33 SPEAKING WITH AH DID SHE SHARE ANYTHING WITH YOU THAT WAS
34 CONCERNING?

35 ■ UM SHE WAS VERY OPEN ■ SHE
36 WAS VERY OPEN WITH UM WITH WHAT WAS GOING ON BETWEEN HER
37 AND JOSH UM SHE STATED THAT THINGS WEREN'T GOOD UM THIS WAS A
38 COUPLE MONTHS BEFORE LET'S SEE THIS WAS LIKE IN I'D SAY MAYBE
39 JUNE OF LAST YEAR HOW THINGS WEREN'T GOOD WITH HER AND JOSH
40 AND THAT UM AH SHE WAS HAVING, SHE HAD A SEPARATE BANK
41 ACCOUNT AND SHE STARTED DOING THINGS THAT HE DIDN'T WANT HER
42 TO DO LIKE PAYING HER TITHING AND UM BUYING EXTRA GROCERIES
43 AND CAUSE HE WOULDN'T LET HER BUY MORE THAN A CERTAIN AMOUNT
44 OF GROCERIES AND CERTAIN ITEMS AT THE STORE. UM SHE STATED THAT
45 SHE, THAT HE WOULDN'T LISTEN TO WHAT SHE HAD TO SAY ABOUT
46 CERTAIN THINGS SO SHE WROTE HIM A LETTER AND UM HE, AND LEFT IT
47 FOR HIM TO READ AND HE DIDN'T EVEN RESPOND TO THAT LETTER.

49 ■ SHE JUST STATED HOW FRUSTRATED SHE WAS AND THAT SHE WANTED
50 THINGS TO CHANGE AND SHE TALKED ABOUT HOW THEY HAVEN'T,
51 HAVEN'T HAD SEXUAL RELATIONS FOR SINCE THEY CONCEIVED THEIR

52 LAST SON AND HOW SHE JUST FRUSTRATED SHE WAS WITH EVERYTHING
53 BUT WHEN THAT'S, I MEAN SHE WAS OPEN PRETTY MUCH WITH
54 EVERYBODY SHE WAS AN OPEN BOOK.

56 ■ UM BUT OTHER THAN THAT IT JUST KIND OF GIRLY CHURCH STUFF
57 NOTHING.

58 EM: YEAH

59 ■ YOU KNOW.

60 EM: SHE SAID THERE WAS ANY PHYSICAL ABUSE IN THE HOME AT ALL OR?

61 ■ NO AH SHE NEVER SAID THAT THERE WAS ANY PHYSICAL VIOLENCE OR
62 ANYTHING SHE WAS WORRIED ABOUT. UM THE KIDS IN ANY WAY, AH SHE
63 NEVER SAID THAT HE HIT HER OR....

64 EM: SO IT SOUNDS MORE LIKE HE WAS JUST VERY CONTROLLING?

■ ■ I KNOW LIKE ■ WAS IN THE WARD TO AND UM WHEN ■
68 ■ RIGHT BEFORE THIS LAST ONE, UM
69 SHE WAS WOULD TELL ■ THAT HE WOULDN'T LET HER BUY
70 CERTAIN FOODS AND THAT SHE HAD TO RIDE HER BIKE TO WORK UM
71 BECAUSE HE WOULDN'T PAY FOR THE GAS IN THE CAR AND UM THERE
72 WERE TIMES THAT THEY DIDN'T HAVE ANY FOOD IN THE HOUSE. BUT

101 EM: UM HUH....OKAY SO...SO SHE WAS THE FIRST PERSON TO MAKE CONTACT

102 WITH YA IN THE NEIGHBORHOOD?

104 EM: OKAY...DO AH SHE EVER EXPRESS THAT SHE HAD ANY BOY FRIENDS OR

105 INTERESTED IN ANYBODY OUTSIDE JUST BECAUSE THE LACK OF

109 [REDACTED] BUT NO BOY FRIENDS AH SHE HAD AH A GUY FRIEND THAT SOMETIMES

110 WOULD GIVE HER A RIDE HOME FROM WORK BECAUSE UM SHE DIDN'T
111 HAVE A CAR OR JOSH COULDN'T PICK HER UP.

112 EM: UM HUH.

113 █ I HAVE NO IDEA WHAT HIS NAME IS

114 EM: OKAY

115 █ BUT SHE JUST SAID THAT THEY WERE MORE FRIENDS THAT HE WAS A
116 NICE GUY AND HE WAS MARRIED.

117 EM: DO YOU KNOW OF HER TO HAVE ANY ENEMIES OR PROBLEMS WITH
118 ANYBODY?

119 █ NO, NO I, I SUSAN WAS ONE OF THE MOST SWEET GENUINE PEOPLE SO I
120 DON'T KNOW OF ANYBODY WHO WOULD EVER WANT TO HURT OR HATE
121 HER IN ANY WAY CAUSE SHE WAS JUST SO SWEET.

122 EM: DID YOU KNOW JOSH AT ALL?

123 █ I KNEW JOSH A LITTLE BIT BUT MOSTLY EVERYTHING I KNOW ABOUT
124 JOSH WAS IN PASSING.

125 EM: SO YOU NEVER REALLY SPOKE WITH HIM AT GREAT LENGTHS OR?

126 █ UM NO HE.

127 EM: BECAME CLOSE TO HIM AT ALL?

128 █ HE WAS KIND OF WEIRD AND I GUESS HE'S STILL PROBABLY IS KIND OF
129 WEIRD

130 EM: UM HUH.

131 █ UM IF YOU WOULD LIKE BE HAVING A DISCUSSION OR A GROUP TALK
132 AND HE WOULD KIND OF LET HIMSELF IN THE CONVERSATION AND THEN
133 HE'D LIKE FOLLOW YOU OUT THE DOOR EVEN IF THE CONVERSATION WAS
134 DONE AND HE JUST WAS I NEVER UNDERSTOOD HIS PERSONALITY SO
135 MAYBE I WAS THE ONE WHO DIDN'T TRY TO GET TO KNOW HIM BUT NO I
136 NEVER KNEW ANYTHING MORE THAN THE LITTLE BIT OF YOU KNOW HI
137 HOW ARE YOU.

138 EM: RIGHT.

139 ■ I KNOW THAT IT JUST SEEMED HE WOULD NOT COME TO CHURCH FOR A
140 WHILE AND THEN WHEN HE WANTED HELP ON SOMETHING HE'D COME TO
141 CHURCH FOR A FEW WEEKS AND THEN ASK FOR HELP FROM THE WARD
142 AND THEN HE'D STOP COMING AFTER TWO OR THREE WEEKS AFTER THAT.

147 ■ LIKE TO FINISH HIS DECK THIS LAST SUMMER HE WASN'T COMING TO
148 CHURCH FOR LIKE SIX MONTHS AND SUSAN WAS HAVING A REALLY BIG
149 ISSUE WITH THAT CAUSE THEY MET AT CHURCH AND SHE WAS REALLY
150 FRUSTRATED AND THEN ALL OF A SUDDEN ONE DAY HE COMES TO
151 CHURCH AND THEN THE NEXT SUNDAY HE GOES TO CHURCH AGAIN AND
152 THEN HE ASKS THE ELDERS QUORUM PRESIDENCY TO HELP HIM WITH HIS
153 DECK AND THEY WERE THERE THE NEXT SATURDAY CAUSE MY
154 HUSBANDS IN THE ELDERS QUORUM PRESIDENCY.

170 EM: UM AFTER HE SHOWED UP THE SECOND TIME ASKED FOR HELP AND THEN
171 THE FOLLOWING WEEK UM HE GOT HELP, DID HE COME BACK TO CHURCH
172 THAT FOLLOWING WEEK AFTER THAT?
173 ■ HE CAME TO CHURCH FOR ANOTHER TWO WEEKS.
174 EM: UM HUH.
175 ■ AND THEN IT WAS SUNDAY (INAUDIBLE)
176 EM: AH HUH. OKAY.....ALRIGHT WHAT WAS YOU GONNA SAY I'M SORRY JUST
177 (INAUDIBLE)
178 ■ UM HE I, I, I DO KNOW THAT SHE TOLD ME THAT HE PUT A PASSWORD AND
179 LOCKED HER OUT OF THE COMPUTERS SO SHE COULDN'T USE THEM AT
180 HOME.
181 EM: UM HUH.
182 ■ AND THAT WAS JUST ONE THING I REMEMBERED WHEN I THOUGHT
183 ABOUT HOW POSSESSIVE HE WAS OF HIS THINGS.
184 EM: UM...OKAY
185 ■ SO.
186 EM: ALRIGHT
187 ■ BUT I DON'T, UNFORTUNATELY I DON'T HAVE VERY MUCH INFORMATION
188 THAT PROBABLY WOULD HELP BUT.
189 EM: NO YOU'RE GOOD. WHAT AH SO I HEARD THAT I GUESS HE ATTENDED
190 CHURCH MAYBE THREE TIMES IN NOVEMBER?
191 ■ HE, HE DID HE ATTENDED CHURCH A COUPLE TIMES AND UM
192 EM: BUT PRIOR TO THAT HE NEVER, HE HADN'T ATTENDED FOR SEVERAL
193 MONTHS?
194 ■ THAT'S TRUE HE WASN'T THERE FOR A WHILE. HE CAME WHEN HE
195 WANTED TO GET HIS STUFF DONE AND THEN HE DIDN'T COME FOR A
196 WHILE AND THEN HE STARTED COMING IN NOVEMBER AGAIN.

198 APPROXIMATELY ON THE DECK?
