Susan and Josh moved into the neighborhood I grew up in when I was in high school. I have actually never spoken to Josh but have spoken to Susan in the past. Susan [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. Her partner was [REDACTED]. They only came to visit me once. They stayed a couple of hours. At the time Susan only had [REDACTED] and had brought him with her. Most of the time the conversation was between Susan [REDACTED]. Susan seemed to enjoy the time away and talked mostly about her family back home. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] for a couple of months this past year, from April until December 2009. When I moved back Josh had seemed to have become inactive. Susan brought her two boys by herself to church. About two or three months before Susan went missing Josh had started attending church again but not consistently. He seemed more standoffish than he was years before [REDACTED] the ward. Susan on the other hand was very outgoing. As you probably know she was the secretary in the Relief Society. She got up every week and announced something in the "good news" minute in Relief Society. She also bore her testimony every fast Sunday. I do not remember a time when she didn't. Susan discussed a couple of times in her testimony the struggles she was having with Josh and him not being active. She would also mention the difficulties of bringing her children to church alone but knew how important it was. She would also briefly mention troubles at home but how much reading her scriptures and prayer has helped her overcome trials. When Josh slowly started coming again before her disappearance Susan mentioned in Relief Society for the good news minute how grateful she was that the ward was so welcoming to Josh when he came. Susan would also always mention ways she had found to save money such as making homemade bread and having a garden. She would also discuss how it was her responsibility to take care of the children after she got off work. She would make sure she picked them up from daycare. Susan made friends with everyone. She was not the type of person to be shy. Although you knew she had struggles she was always very positive and very open. You knew she made friends everywhere she went because she would always be talking about the different people in her life. Unfortunately I can not give you much information about Josh since I personally have not spoken to him. [REDACTED] has spoken to Josh and did work for him very briefly [REDACTED] [REDACTED]
