My family was very trusting of her, and we always enjoyed having her over. She was a very popular girl in school, very happy and easy to get along with. I knew her not only as our babysitter but as a friend through church activities and neighbor. It is very strange that she would vanish the way she did. She adored her family and would do anything for her children. It is not like her, which is why this case is so suspicious to all of us who know her.

I met her husband Josh [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. When I met her husband he was nice, although a little awkward. I knew that he was very good at carpentry because of the entertainment center he had made that was displayed in their living room. Josh was very quiet and I suppose I was a little distant from him as well because I knew that he had trouble holding down a consistent job and that there were some small problems in their marriage, nothing I am sure you have not already heard about. I knew that things were not easy for Susan and I felt bad for her, although she was displayed a very happy countenance. I do not know much more about him other than the small conversation I had with him at his house, and the things her family have briefly mentioned about him in passing.

I hope all works out in the case and that an answer can be formulated to explain her disappearance. I apologize I do not have more to share. Please keep us up to date with any new information that you have.
