5 YA IN PERSON

7 EM: WE'VE MADE CONTACT OVER THE PHONE OKAY, AND UM YOU LIVE IN ON  
8 [REDACTED] RIGHT?  
9 [REDACTED] OH [REDACTED] OVER THERE AND I'M PRETTY MUCH THERE  
10 EM: OH IS THAT WHERE YOU'RE [REDACTED] ?  
11 [REDACTED] YEAH I'M THERE ALMOST EVERY DAY. I USE TO LIVE THERE I DON'T LIVE  
12 THERE ANYMORE.  
13 EM: AND YOU'RE LAST NAMES [REDACTED]

15 EM: OKAY UM NOW DETECTIVE OR OFFICER [REDACTED] EXPLAINED [REDACTED] HE  
16 KIND OF TOLD ME SOME OF THE STUFF

18 EM: UM AND BEFORE YOU GET INTO UM WHAT ELSE YOU HAVE AND WHERE  
19 HE MENTIONED SOMETHING ABOUT A CELLAR BEING IN THE BASEMENT  
20 WHERE EXACTLY WAS THAT CELLAR?  
21 [REDACTED] UM THE STORAGE CELLAR WAS IF YOU WENT DOWN THE STAIRS AND  
22 EM: UM HUH.

23 [REDACTED] TURNED RIGHT AND WALKED ALL THE WAY STRAIGHT FORWARD  
24 EM: THROUGH THE DOOR THERE?  
25 [REDACTED] AH HUH.  
26 EM: OKAY, ALRIGHT  
27 [REDACTED] AND HE WAS, HE KEPT IT PRETTY MUCH SECLUDED YOU KNOW HAVING  
28 US NOT EVEN GO IN THAT DIRECTION BUT THEN WHEN WE WENT HOME  
29 AND HAD DINNER AND HE EMPTIED IT ALL HIM AND HIS BROTHER WERE  
30 THERE AND THEY HAD EMPTIED IT ALL OUT, AND WHEN WE WENT BACK  
31 UM HAD, HAD US GO DOWN IN THERE AND I THOUGHT IT WAS AWFULLY  
32 STRANGE THAT THEY TOOK DOWN ALL THE SHELVINGS IN THERE  
33 INCLUDING THE 2X4 LIKE EVERYTHING JUST STRIPPED IT DOWN, AND ON  
34 THE INSULATION ON THE ONE WALL ON THE ONE SIDE WHERE HE  
35 STRIPPED HE TOOK ALL THE SHELVES OUT BUT ON THAT ONE SIDE HE  
36 TOOK THE 2X4'S AND EVERYTHING THAT WAS HOLDING THE SHELVES UP  
37 AND THERE WAS SOME IT WAS KIND OF A REDDISH COLORED STUFF ON  
38 THE INSULATION.  
39 EM: UM HUH  
40 [REDACTED] AND I'M NOT EXACTLY SURE WHAT IT WAS BUT WE GOT TAPE AND STUCK  
41 IT ON THERE THAT I HAVE IF YOU GUYS WANT IT, BECAUSE WHEN WE  
42 HAD COME BACK THERE WAS RED DROPS OF SOMETHING ON THE  
43 UPSTAIRS KITCHEN FLOOR AND I WAS LOOKING AT IT AND HE GOES, "OH  
44 NO BLOOD HURRY AND CLEAN IT UP", AND I WAS JUST LIKE WHAT CAUSE  
45 HE KEPT CRACKING JOKES ABOUT LIKE WHEN I GOT BACK HE SAID, "I  
46 JUST LOADED SUSAN'S HEAD INTO THE TRUCK"  
47 EM: UM HUH.  
48 [REDACTED] AND I KIND OF JUST IGNORED HIM AND YOU KNOW KIND OF BLEW IT OFF  
49 EM: UM HUH.  
50 [REDACTED] BECAUSE I FIGURED HE WAS TRYING TO GET SOME KIND OF RISE OUT OF  
51 ME WELL THEN HE SAID IT AGAIN AND HE GOES, "DID YOU JUST HEAR

52 WHAT I SAID?" AND I GO YEAH, AND HE GOES I DON'T THINK YOU DID AND  
53 HE SAID IT AGAIN, "I JUST LOADED SUSAN'S HEAD INTO THE TRUCK".

54 EM: UM HUH

55 ■ AND I LOOKED HE GOES YOU DIDN'T HEAR WHAT I SAID DID YA? AND I GO  
56 YEAH AND I GO WHAT KIND OF A HEAD A MANEQUIN HEAD AND HE WAS  
57 LIKE OH HOW DID YA KNOW AND HE JUST KIND OF LAUGHED ABOUT IT,  
58 BUT HE KEPT CRACKING KIND OF JOKES LIKE THAT

59 EM: UM HUH.

60 ■ AND I THOUGHT OH NO, YOU KNOW I DON'T KNOW IT JUST KIND OF SEEMS  
61 INAPPROPRIATE AT, AT THE TIME TO BE CRACKING JOKES LIKE THAT, BUT  
62 SO I GOT A PIECE OF TAPE AND I GOT WHATEVER THE RED STUFF ON THE  
63 FLOOR WAS THAT HE SAID WAS BLOOD AND THEN UM I GOT TAPE OF  
64 WHATEVER WAS ON THE INSULATION IN THAT CELLAR THAT HE STRIPPED  
65 DOWN ON THAT ONE SIDE THAT HE STRIPPED ALL DOWN, AND I DON'T  
66 KNOW IF YOU GUYS WANT IT OR IF IT'S A KNOWN IMPORTANT SOURCE.

68 ■ BUT I HAD TOLD ■ FAMILY ABOUT IT AND THEY GO YEAH YOU SHOULD  
69 YOU PROBABLY SHOULD CALL AND I JUST THOUGHT

71 ■ AH SINCE HE FIRST MOVED OUT THOSE THREE, FIRST THREE DAYS. I'VE  
72 HAD IT FOR A LONG TIME I THOUGHT IT'S KIND OF DUMB CAUSE  
73 FORENSICES WAS IN THERE BUT THEN YOU KNOW ■ DAUGHTER SAYS  
74 WELL THAT ROOM WAS ALL THE WAY FULL WE COULD SEE IT FULL WHEN  
75 THEY WOULD SWING THE DOOR SHUT WHEN WE'D GO DOWN THERE

76 EM: UM HUH

77 ■ AND I WAS LIKE YEAH AND THEY ■ LIKE YEAH IT  
78 COULD HAVE BEEN BURIED WITH STUFF AND WE STARTED SAYING WHY  
79 IS HE TAKING THE SHELVING OUT YOU KNOW WHEN HE'S PLANNING ON  
80 COMING BACK ANY WAY SO, I THOUGHT YEAH THAT'S KIND OF WEIRD TO

81 STRIP THAT WHOLE SIDE COMPLETELY DOWN OF EVERYTHING  
82 INCLUDING THE 2X4'S

83 EM: RIGHT

84 ■ SO I DON'T KNOW IF IT'S OF WOULD BE IMPORTANT OR ANYTHING BUT I  
85 DO HAVE THE, I TOOK TWO PIECES OF TAPE OFF THE, THE INSULATION  
86 AND THEN ONE OFF THE STUFF THAT HE SAID WAS BLOOD ON THE  
87 KITCHEN FLOOR BUT I DON'T, I DON'T THINK IT WAS BLOOD WHATEVER  
88 IT WAS IT SEEMED OILY BUT AND HE NEVER EVER, EVER SAID THAT IT  
89 WASN'T AND THEN I WAS KIND OF CREEPED OUT BY IT AND I WENT A  
90 LITTLE FURTHER DO YOU HAVE RUBBER GLOVES OR SOMETHING SO WE  
91 CAN CLEAN THIS, THIS FAKE BLOOD OR I SAID SOMETHING ABOUT FAKE  
92 BLOOD I CAN'T REMEMBER RED DROPS OR WHATEVER IT WAS OFF THE  
93 KITCHEN FLOOR, AND HE GOES I DON'T THINK IT'S BLOOD I THINK IT'S  
94 SOMETHING OUT OF THE GARAGE

95 EM: UM HUH

96 ■ BUT ANY WAYS

97 EM: OKAY

98 ■ I DON'T KNOW IF IT'S OF ANY IMPORTANCE WHATSOEVER OR WHAT IT IS,  
99 BECAUSE THE WHOLE TIME WE WERE THERE HELPING HIM MOVE I NEVER  
100 SEEN ANY KIND OF RED LIQUID AT ALL THAT IT COULD HAVE BEEN, SO I  
101 DON'T KNOW WHAT IT IS.

102 EM: OKAY, ALRIGHT THAT WORKS WHAT UM...WHAT ARE YOU PLANS  
103 TOMORROW?

104 ■ UM WELL I HAVE A REALLY ODD SCHEDULE I USUALLY UP UNTIL LIKE

107 ■ SO I WORK OUT ■ AND I'M HOME  
108 INBETWEEN THAT, THAT TIME

109 EM: OKAY

110 [REDACTED] UM BUT I'LL BE UP TIL [REDACTED] TONIGHT HOPE, I'D HOPE TO GO TO SLEEP  
111 SOONER BUT THAT NEVER SEEMS TO HAPPEN

112 EM: YEAH, UM TOMORROW.....I'LL BE IN THE OFFICE, YOU WANT TO COME BY  
113 THE OFFICE TOMORROW?

114 [REDACTED] I DON'T HAVE A VEHICLE

115 EM: OH YOU DON'T?

116 [REDACTED] NO AND, AND SO

117 EM: IS WHAT I'LL DO, IS WHAT I'LL DO
