To Whom It May Concern:

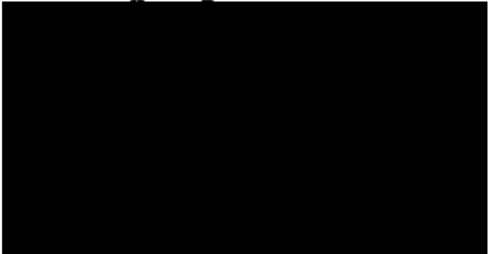
[REDACTED] is an at risk child due to a vigilante mob being led and encouraged by people who claim to be friends and family. His photographic/video image and private information have been published in media and web outlets against my wishes. This presents a very real threat of danger to [REDACTED] from outsiders of any kind.

**In order to protect Charlie's physical safety and emotional wellbeing, he must be kept away from anyone claiming to be a friend or family member unless explicitly authorized by me to have contact. If anyone attempts contact with [REDACTED] please contact me immediately.**

I do not want [REDACTED] academic progress interrupted. So if possible please forbid all outsiders from entering [REDACTED] classroom unless they are related to another student (this includes any space while it is occupied by [REDACTED]). If you cannot legally stop them from entering [REDACTED] space, you are instructed to immediately hold Charlie in a private area away from the outsiders and contact us. We will pick up [REDACTED] from school and seek other remedies as needed.

Despite sharing my last name, these individuals are also to have no contact with [REDACTED] while he is under the care of the school district:

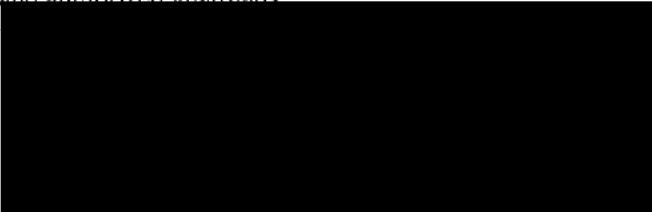
- Susan Powell (Charlie's mother who is currently a missing person)

Oct. 5 Charlie's Aunt Alina talked to me before school. She said [REDACTED] had come home from school with a "knick" above his left eye. He couldn't remember how he had gotten it. She said his dad was very concerned about it. I told her I'd talk to [REDACTED]. When I talked to [REDACTED], he seemed confused. He told me several different stories, including someone poking him in class with a broken pencil (he didn't know who or when) and getting the scratch in line before school.

Oct. 6 Alina asked me again about the small cut. I told her I couldn't get a straight story from [REDACTED] about the cut. I mentioned that kids gets cuts and scrapes all the time in Kindergarten, and that he may have done it to himself. She suggested that I have Charlie talk to the school counselor to see if she could get the story. I said I wanted her to run the idea by [REDACTED] dad first.

Oct. 7 Alina said Josh was fine with [REDACTED] seeing the counselor. Erynn offered to call and talk with him.

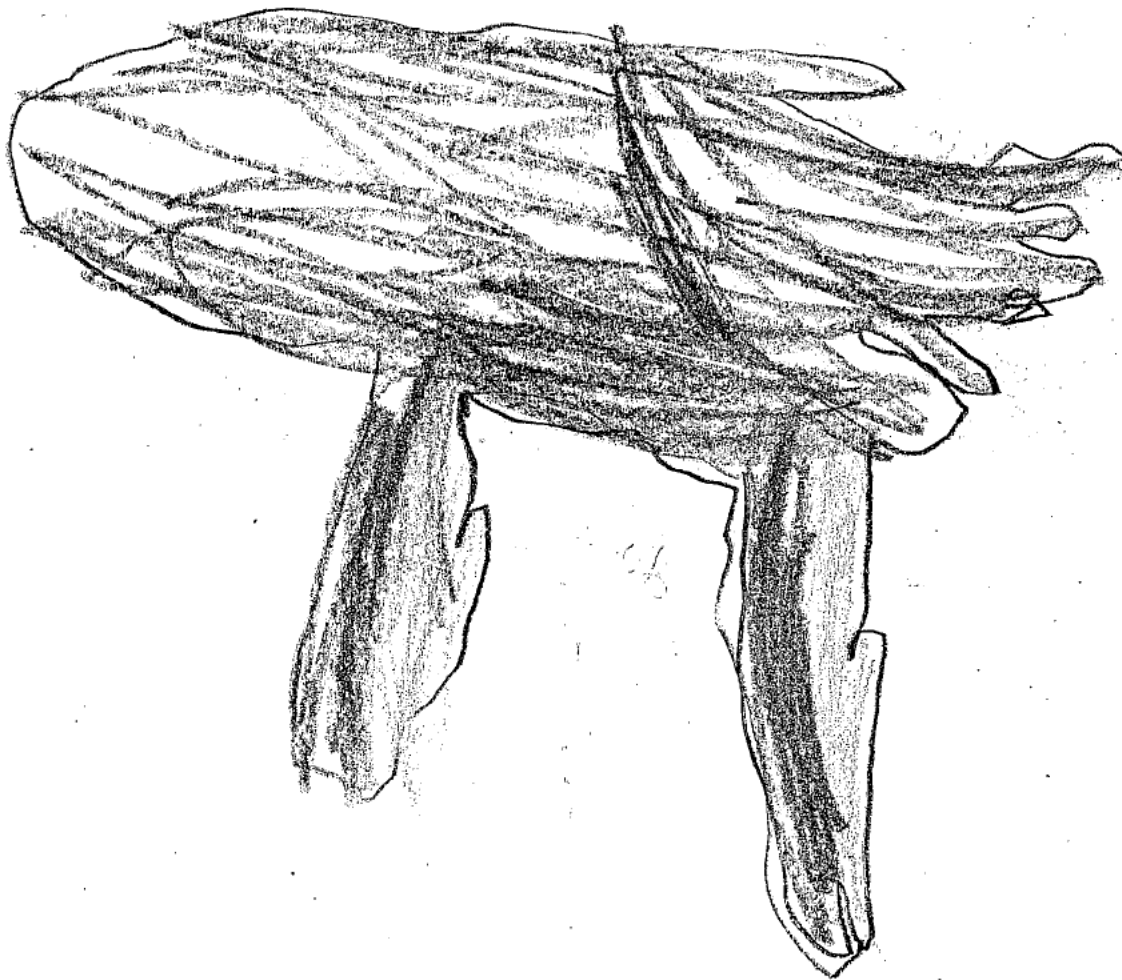
Oct. 25 [REDACTED] told me it's wrong to swear, but "it's okay to swear around Mormons." He said, "If you swear around Mormons, they will tell you to stop. But if you don't stop they will go away. So you should swear around Mormons." I told him we don't use bad words at school.

Feb. 15 [REDACTED] was talking with [REDACTED]'s table group about siblings. [REDACTED] said, [REDACTED], you have a little brother, too, right?" Charlie responded, "No, not any more. The Mormons killed my little brother and my mom." Another child, Dylan, said, "You don't have a little brother anymore? He's dead?" [REDACTED] said, "Yeah, it's just me and my dad." Dylan said, "Oh, so he's turned to dirt." [REDACTED] did not respond.

May 3 [REDACTED] overheard Matthew say that [REDACTED] mom was dead. He marched over to [REDACTED] table and shouted, "My mom's not dead. She's just away from her parents, because they abused her until she was 47. That's when she left [REDACTED] lying." This was at 9:10 a.m. A little later, at 9:45 a.m., I asked [REDACTED] if he was feeling better. He said, "I feel a little better because I'm really smart and I can figure out a way for liars like [REDACTED] to go to jail for 14 years."

June 10 [REDACTED] wanted to sit by [REDACTED] on the bus. [REDACTED] said no. [REDACTED] said that [REDACTED] threatened to kill him at night if he didn't stop asking to sit by him. [REDACTED] said, "I won't even be alive if I still know you when I'm a grown-up 'cause Mormons kills scientists." He started crying. I told the boys it is not okay to talk about killing at school. I asked [REDACTED] to take them to see if [REDACTED] was available. On the way to [REDACTED] office, [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] that his mom lives about a mile from him. He said that she can't see him because her parents are Mormon and they abuse her. Later in the morning, [REDACTED] came and got the boys and took them to her office. I wrote notes to both children's parents.
