1. Lagoon

- Bring a coke can and save \$7 on a regular day-pass if purchased before noon. One can is valid for up to 6 people. Not valid on Saturdays (info HERE)
- Sign up for the "<u>Fun Time Club" email list</u>. They send out special offers & discounts to their email list, like this <u>Memorial Day coupon</u> from a while back.
- Discount coupons at Deseret Book. Lagoon coupons are linked to specific products within their catalog. For every product you buy you get a discount coupon, whether you buy online or in the store. The coupon is for a day pass price of \$38.95, savings of \$9. The eligible items can be found in the store and in their online catalog.
- Discounted passes at Costco. Costco is a great place to buy passes to anything from ski resorts to Disneyland and, yes, Lagoon! You can currently get Lagoon day Passes for \$39.99 (vs \$47.95)
- Bounce-back passes. The last time we went to Lagoon we got bounce-back passes which allowed us to return to Lagoon
 (within a certain window of dates) for a discount. So be sure to ask them at the ticket counter and/or check the back of
 your tickets if you don't hear anything about it at the park.
- Buy a season passport. If you <u>buy BEFORE JUNE 8</u> you get a season passport for just \$96.95 (for 4 or more passports in one transaction). You only have to go 2x to make it worth the cost! After June 8 it goes up to \$107 which is still a better value if you plan to visit multiple times this summer.

2. Cowabunga Bay

- Kids 2 and under are free. So if you have young kids it's perfect (see HERE for how little-kid friendly it is).
- Pay for the time you need. You can buy just a <u>4-hour pass</u> for as low as \$12.95, just over \$3/hr. This is an affordable option for those who can't or don't want to commit to a full day.
- If you go after 5:00pm it's as low as \$9.95. It closes at 7 most nights so you're paying closer to \$5/hr, but it's still nice if, again, you want to swim without committing to a full day.
- Buy a daily-deal deal! Cowabunga Bay is going CRAZY on daily deal sites right now! On <u>Groupon</u> you can get a season pass for \$64.99 instead of \$109.99 price. On <u>KSL deals</u> you can get 4 all-day passes + pizza and drinks for \$59.99 (\$15 per person), which is 52% off.
- Keep your eyes peeled. I just got an email from my local gym that THEY are offering discounted Cowabunga Bay tickets to members! Call Cowabunga Bay and ask them what offers they have out and I bet they'd be able to point you in the right direction.
- Buy a season pass. Again, if you plan to visit more than a few times this summer, a season pass will save you money. Their passes are pretty creative too their flex pass is transferable between two adults. So our family friend split that pass with my husband, since he can only go with us on the weekends. So our friend bought passes for her kids, split the flex pass with Bubba, and saved money that way. Their plus pass (included in the Groupon deal above) allows you to bring in one friend each time you come. I bought a discounted plus pass for my son this year (see how below). His name will be on the pass and I will have myself be his guest each time I go, but if he wants to go to Cowabunga Bay with a friend or with my husband for a father-son outing, his pass will work to get whoever he's with in for free!
- Buy off-season. I bought a plus pass for my son in March, when it was only \$149. Get on email lists and keep your eyes peeled in the winter for screaming deals.
- SpongeBob Square Pants is coming June 14 10-11 for pass holders only 11 1

3. Connect pass

• It's available as a 1 day (\$24), 2 day (\$34), 3 day (\$46), or 365-day (\$63) consecutive pass (more for adults and kids over 12).

- The pass is activated the first time you use it and remains active for the number of consecutive days purchased.
- It allows you to visit as many of the <u>13 major Salt Lake City attractions</u> as you like while the Connect Pass is active (but you are limited to only one (1) visitation at each participating attraction). Attractions include Red Butte Garden, This Is The Place Heritage Park, Hogle Zoo, Tracy Aviary, Olympic Park, Clark Planetarium, Discovery Gateway, and more.

4. Drive-in movies

- <u>HERE</u> is a great site that shows all the drive-in theaters in Utah. Yes, there is probably one near you!
- You can watch the movie from your car, or you can bring blankets, camping chairs, or bean bags to watch outside.
- Go early to get a good seat. Bring a picnic dinner and a frisbee or glove/ball to play around before the movie.
- Pets are basically never allowed and you'll be turned away so don't even try to smuggle in your dog. Not saying that I've tried...he'em...cough, cough...is it hot in here?
