Salt Lake City recently became aware of an ongoing investigation by the Federal Bureau of Investigations that touches on matters related to the Salt Lake City Police Department's relationship with foundations. Our understanding is that the investigation, which was not initiated by the City, has been open for some time. Now that I am aware of the investigation, I have decided to put a hold on the Police Department's involvement with all current and future activities with the Police Mutual Aid Association (PMAA) and the Salt Lake City Police Foundation (SLCPF).

This hold applies to the City's involvement with all current and future activities of the PMAA and the SLCPF, including but not limited to: the use of City property for meetings and events, unless arranged through the City's usual process; use of City employee on-duty time and City resources for meetings and events; use of City property for fundraising activities; and use of City logos or icons, including the SLCPD badge. Further, City facilitated payroll deductions to the PMAA will be put on hold and affected employees will be notified of that action.

I recognize the good intentions of the PMAA and the SLCPF and the men and women who support the organizations' efforts through their donations of time and money. I will let you know when I revisit this decision.
