
EASY HALLOWEEN RUNNER

as seen on Studio 5

1. Make a "strip set" of the 3 different fabrics by sewing one strip to another using a 1/4" seam allowance.



2. Using the 60 degree ruler, cut 6 triangles from the strip set. Rotate the ruler back and forth to get as many cuts as possible from the set. Set the top of the triangle ruler on the edge of the strip set. It should measure 9.5" tall. Keep cutting back and forth, back and forth.



3. Place Heat-n-Bond Lite on the BACK of each pieced triangle. Press.

4. Peel paper backing off each triangle and place on fabric background.

5. Blanket-stitch around each triangle.

An added "flair" might be to make one of your triangles with glitter applique sheets! Add buttons for spiders! Use fabric flowers to dress it up, too!

MATERIALS:

- 3/8 yard background fabric
- (1) 2.5" x WOF strip top fabric
- (1) 5" x WOF strip middle fabric
- (1) 3.5" x WOF strip bottom fabric
- 1/4 yard binding fabric
- 60 degree triangle ruler
