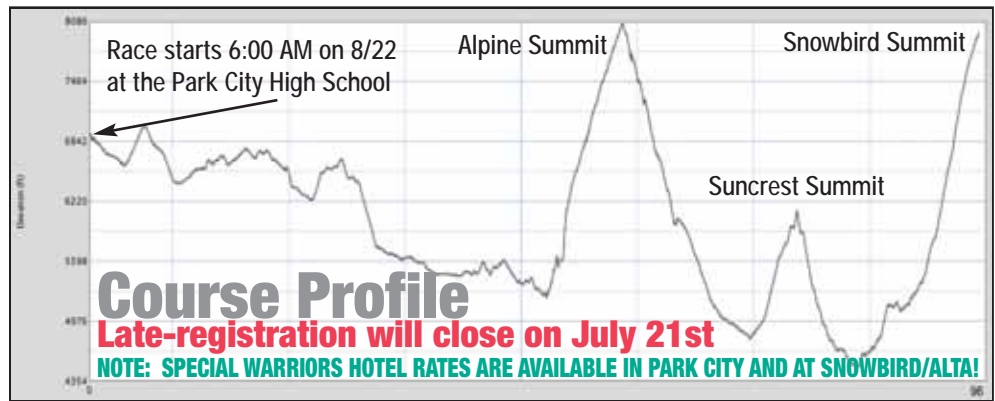
Five hours earlier, starting at 6:00 AM, **1000 Warriors** will charge out on the same course. If the winning Warrior beats the time of the subsequent Tour of Utah professional stage winner, then you'll not only get the \$1000 Warrior cash award, but you'll get... The Glory.

Last year we had nice "fun ride" with 300 Warriors. No timing chips. No real winners. This year, we're closing Alpine Loop to all automobile traffic, and we're hiring a lot of police support. Because it's going to be... **A Real War. With Real Warriors** as our guests.

We have invited Purple Heart Marines to use this race as a rehabilitation training goal. All were wounded in Afghanistan or in Iraq. When you sign up at SportsBaseOnline, you will be invited to contribute to a scholarship fund for **Children of Wounded Warriors**. 100% of your contribution will go to those scholarships, **with NO management overhead**. The Larry H. Miller family will pay all overhead, and 100% of your donated funds will be disbursed through Larry H. Miller Charities.

In case you're wondering why there is only one cash prize, your registration fees will go toward Tour of Utah operating expenses. All registrants will receive racing caps, **personalized with your name on them**. Along with the chance to order limited-edition 1000 Warriors cycling accessories.

The race starts at the Park City High School • \$10 chip rental is by CC only (no cash/checks) • And although this is a USAC-sanctioned event, because we're not offering a shorter competition for Junior riders (Juniors may want to sign up for the Snowbird Hill Climb event being held on the same day), this WILL NOT be a UCA points race.
