

Hip Hip Hooray!

It's Party Popper Time!

Party Popper Ingredients:

- Plastic Push Pops
- Homemade Confetti (tissue paper, metallic fringe, crinkle paper)
- Patterned Paper
- Scissors
- 1 inch hole punch
- tape
- double sided adhesive or fast setting glue
- spray paint
- Paper cutter

Party Popper Instructions:



make your own fun filled confetti using an assortment of tissue paper, crinkle bag filler and metallic filler. Trim crinkle and metallic filler into small confetti sized pieces using scissors. You can cut tissue paper with scissors or a paper cutter, or to create the circle confetti, use a 1" circle punch and punch through several layers of tissue at a time. *Note* if your tissue is too flimsy to punch, try added more layers.



1. Use Spray paint to paint "push stick" of party popper. Allow to dry well before placing in popper.
2. Fill the popper with desired amount of confetti.
3. Top popper with a small square of tissue paper. Tape around the edge of the tissue to secure in place.
4. Cut a strip of patterned paper to the correct height and width so that it wraps around your popper with a small amount of overlap.
5. Adhere patterned paper to popper with double sided adhesive.
6. Pass poppers out to guests and get ready for a festive party explosion!

HINT Poppers give a more exciting pop when they have more pressure...to do this, gently press the stick up until it is taught against the tissue, then push the stick upward quickly to get a great POP!
